VdFF Award of Excellence

for Interdisciplinary Research Cooperation 2020 - Call for application

The VdFF Research Award was founded in 1988 by the Association of Friends and Supporters of the Helmholtz Zentrum München (VdFF, www.vdff-helmholtz-muenchen.de) with the aim to encourage interdisciplinary research and cooperation at the Helmholtz Zentrum München. Since then, the award has been given about every two years to the authors of the best interdisciplinary scientific publication on the campus, reflecting research networking across different disciplines and scientific concepts. We kindly invite you to submit your publication which was published or has been accepted for publication since October 2017. The winners will be selected by a jury of recognized senior scientists.

Criteria:

- An original work which was published or has been accepted for publication in a peer-reviewed journal since October 2017.
- The interdisciplinary character of the work, i.e. the cooperation of at least two different subject areas, which has been decisive for overcoming limitations of established disciplines as well as the excellent quality of the work.
- The authors come from at least two different research disciplines/institutes of Helmholtz Zentrum München.

The VdFF Research Award includes a Certificate of Excellence and is endowed with € 1,500 per author, altogether at the most € 7,500. If more than five authors are involved in the publication, the award will be split equally between them. Authors of external cooperation partners are welcome and will also be honored.

A jury coordinated by Prof. Dr. Wolfgang Wurst will select the winners of the award.

The Award Ceremony will take place on July 22, 2020.

Potential candidates, represented by a corresponding author, should submit their original publication together with a short summary highlighting the interdisciplinary character of the work by electronic mail to:
